The Chariton High School Renovation project is well on its way to completion. The project began in the fall of 2008 and is expected to be completed on or before August 2012. The renovation includes: an elevator that will access all areas of the building, a new kitchen addition, an enlarged cafeteria with three additional classrooms, new family consumer science classroom, enlarged music classrooms, and an improved gym commons area with renovated locker rooms and restrooms. The project also includes a new HVAC system along with a facelift for all classrooms (lighting, flooring, ceilings, paint, etc.).
